Chlamydia, gonorrhea PCR	Vaginal discharge	The two most major STDs, causes inflammation in fallopian tubes, abdominal pain and future infertility. If positive, we prescribe antibiotics.	30,250		☆
Trichomoniasis, candida		Causes irritation and increased amount of vaginal discharge.			
High risk HPV		Causes cervical cancer.			
HIV	Blood	Virus transmitted by vaginal discharge and sperm. It causes infection to fetus during pregnancy.			
Syphilis		STD dramatically increases in Japan recently.			
Hepatitis B		Virus transmitted via placenta, blood transfusion and sexual intercourse. All children in Japan are vaccinated.			
Hepatitis C		Causes hepatitis.			
Rubella		Initial infection during early pregnancy causes congenital rubella syndrome in fetus. Vaccination is recommended before pregnancy.

Transvaginal ultrasound		Insert ultrasound probe into your vagina and check uterus, ovaries and other pelvic organs.	6,420
Endometrial cytology (uterine body cancer test)		Put a fine brush inside the uterus to examine the cells of the endometrium. Recommended for those who have abnormal bleeding near menopause.	6,300
